Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Will the individual career plans for 8th graders be structured the same as those for 11th graders, or will they be differentiated by grade level?

A: The career plans will be differentiated by grade level.

Q: How did AccelerateMS envision the 8th grade component being implemented?

A: Implementation will be decided at the local level to best meet the needs of the Career Coach Program, as outlined in the Career Coach RFP, and the local school.

Q: Would there be flexibility to work with 8th or 9th graders?

A: Career Coaches are encouraged to work with students in all grades while meeting the expectations set forth in the RFP to develop career plans with every 8th and 11th grade student.

Q: Will AccelerateMS provide guidance on developmentally appropriate engagement strategies for middle school students?

A: Professional development, offered by the sub grant recipient, should reflect the needs of the coaches in successfully executing the objectives of the career coach program.

Q: Will AccelerateMS provide a standardized career plan framework for both 8th and 11th grade implementation, and will this be delivered through an electronic platform?

A: The career plans will be differentiated by grade level. Career plans will be administered electronically.

Q: Are the MOU's due at the same time as the RFP?

A: Each Memorandum Of Understanding from all served districts/schools are due by June 3rd, but encouraged to be submitted with the Request For Proposal (RFP). All Letters of Intent are due with the submission of the RFP.
