

Request for Quote (RFQ)

Industrial Maintenance Training

1. Introduction

The Mississippi Office of Workforce Development, known as AccelerateMS, seeks qualified vendors with existing capabilities to deliver technical training to the public. The selected vendor will provide strategic expertise and industry insights to strengthen Mississippi's training participation for the selected region and programs.

2. Scope of Work

The selected training provider shall:

Program Delivery

- Deliver a minimum of a One Hundred Forty-Four (144) instructional hours of industrial maintenance-focused training.
- Conduct training in South Central Mississippi.
- **Must be able to conduct the training on-site at company location(s).**
- Provide qualified instructors with demonstrated manufacturing and workforce training experience.
- Maintain attendance records and participant progress documentation.

Curriculum Requirements

Training shall include, at a minimum, instruction in the following areas:

- Safety and Maintenance Fundamentals
- Mechanical Systems
- Pneumatic Systems
- Pneumatic Troubleshooting
- Hydraulic Systems
- Hydraulic Troubleshooting
- Electrical Fundamentals
- Electrical Components and Motor Controls
- Electrical Troubleshooting
- PLC and Industrial Controls
- Pipe Threading and Conduit Bending
- Working from Elevations

Providers are encouraged to include additional industry-relevant content such as:

- Automation and Industry 4.0 concepts

Participant Support

The provider shall:

- Conduct participant assessments as appropriate.
- Monitor participant performance and completion.
- Provide completion documentation and credential attainment records.
- Coordinate with AccelerateMS staff regarding participant progress and outcomes with the capabilities to share data.

3. Deliverables

The selected provider shall provide:

- A detailed training plan and curriculum outline.
- Training schedule identifying instructional hours and topics.
- Instructor qualifications and resumes.
- Attendance records for all participants.
- Participant completion reports.
- Credential attainment documentation, if applicable.
- Final program summary report including:
 - Enrollment numbers
 - Completion rates
 - Credential attainment
 - Participant outcomes
 - Recommendations for future cohorts

4. Vendor Qualifications

Qualified providers should demonstrate:

- Experience delivering manufacturing workforce training programs.
- Experience serving adult learners and workforce populations.
- Capacity to deliver training in South Central Mississippi.
- Familiarity with Mississippi manufacturing industries and workforce needs.
- Success in preparing participants for employment in manufacturing environments.
- Ability to administer or prepare participants for industry-recognized credentials.

Preference may be given to community colleges and those providers with experience supporting:

- Advanced manufacturing
- Industrial maintenance
- Distribution and logistics operations

5. Contract Period

- Start Date: September 21, 2026
- End Date: December 31, 2026
- Extension: Subject to performance and funding availability

6. Quote Requirements

All quotes must include the following:

- Pricing Structure – Fixed monthly or total project fee, OR hourly rate(s) for services provided.
- References – Contact information for two (2) clients or employers for whom similar work was performed.

7. Evaluation Criteria

Relevant industrial maintenance training experience	35%
Quality and comprehensiveness of curriculum	25%
Cost competitiveness and value	25%
Instructor qualifications and organizational capacity	10%
References and past performance	5%

8. Budget Cap

Providers shall submit their most competitive pricing for delivery of the 144-hour training program.

AccelerateMS reserves the right to award all, part, or none of the services requested under this RFQ based on available funding and program needs.
